

## ***IMPORTANT RECERTIFICATION CHANGE FROM THE AAMA!***

**Important notice!** Effective January 1, 2020, an individual whose credential has been expired for more than 90 days forfeits the right to reactivate the credential by continuing education and must sit for the CMA (AAMA) Certification/Recertification Examination.

Steps to maintain your CMA (AAMA):

1. Know the date by which you need to recertify (members can locate this on the AAMA website under your account: [www.aama-ntl.org](http://www.aama-ntl.org))
2. Check your AAMA transcript at frequent intervals on the AAMA website
3. Take advantage of the free CEUs available to Florida AAMA members at the FSMA website: [www.fsmaonline.org](http://www.fsmaonline.org). New modules are posted quarterly under the Constant Learning Tab.
4. Visit the FSMA website under Chapters and Events to view upcoming CEU events (chapter meetings, FSMA conferences and seminars.) These events are open to all medical assistants and students.
